- Guest Speaker Renaë Bennett, Manager of the Plains Producer and the Two Wells Echo, spoke about her history and job. She spent her youth in Quorn, Crystal Brook and Port Pirie. She worked in her parents' real estate business from the age of 12. At 18, she got a job at the Flinders News as an advertising consultant. She was promoted to sales manager, then worked for the Barossa Herald, then in Victor Harbor. She also worked for domain.com before returning to Fairfax Media, managing a team of 45 sales people She has always felt privileged to work in the print media, especially in rural areas. The Plains Producer is a true success story, managing to grow its customer base in a climate of social and internet media. It began in Balaklava in 1903 (The Central Advocate), changed to "The Wooralooka Producer in 1909, then "The Producer" 1940 and finally "The Plains Producer: in 1995. In 2016, it was invited to come into the Clare market. Current circulation is 3,500. The printing press is housed in Kadina, and the paper employs 2 in-house graphic designers (120 hours per week). Renaë believes in the power of country papers, due to their link with local communities. Archives are held in the State Library.
