Julianne Pulford, our representative on the Town Hall Committee, outlined the recent activities of the committee. A screen has been installed by TAFE and is available for use by service organisations. The passageways on either side of the stage are being repaired and repainted by the committee members. The high level curtains in the hall will be replaced by motorised roller blinds. The committee also catered for afternoon tea at the Mayoral Reception for the Veteran Car Rally on Sunday 24th September.
