Hermann Weber told us that 2002 was the first year we started selling O'Leary Walker wine, and this has become our major fundraiser. We sell wine all over Australia. Thanks to O'Leary Walker's generosity, we are able to assist some of the poorest people on earth. He awarded David and Nick a gift certificate for a romantic weekend away. (Not necessarily together!) David acknowledged the late Floyd Brooks as the instigator who accepted David's suggestion to provide their high quality wine at a generous discount.

David spoke briefly about his pathway as a winemaker, acknowledging several local wine identities. O'Leary Walker has always produced top quality wines which retail at over \$30 per bottle. This approach has been successful for 17 years.

We soon adjourned to Watervale Store, to be welcomed by Neil and Louise Haines, before opening the meeting. The store opened in 1851, and successive owners have added their building style, with mixed results. Neil and Louise have gone back to tradition, using local food producers, and they have future plans to diversify the business. We then enjoyed a delicious meal brimming with home cooked flavour.
